When from this school I part.

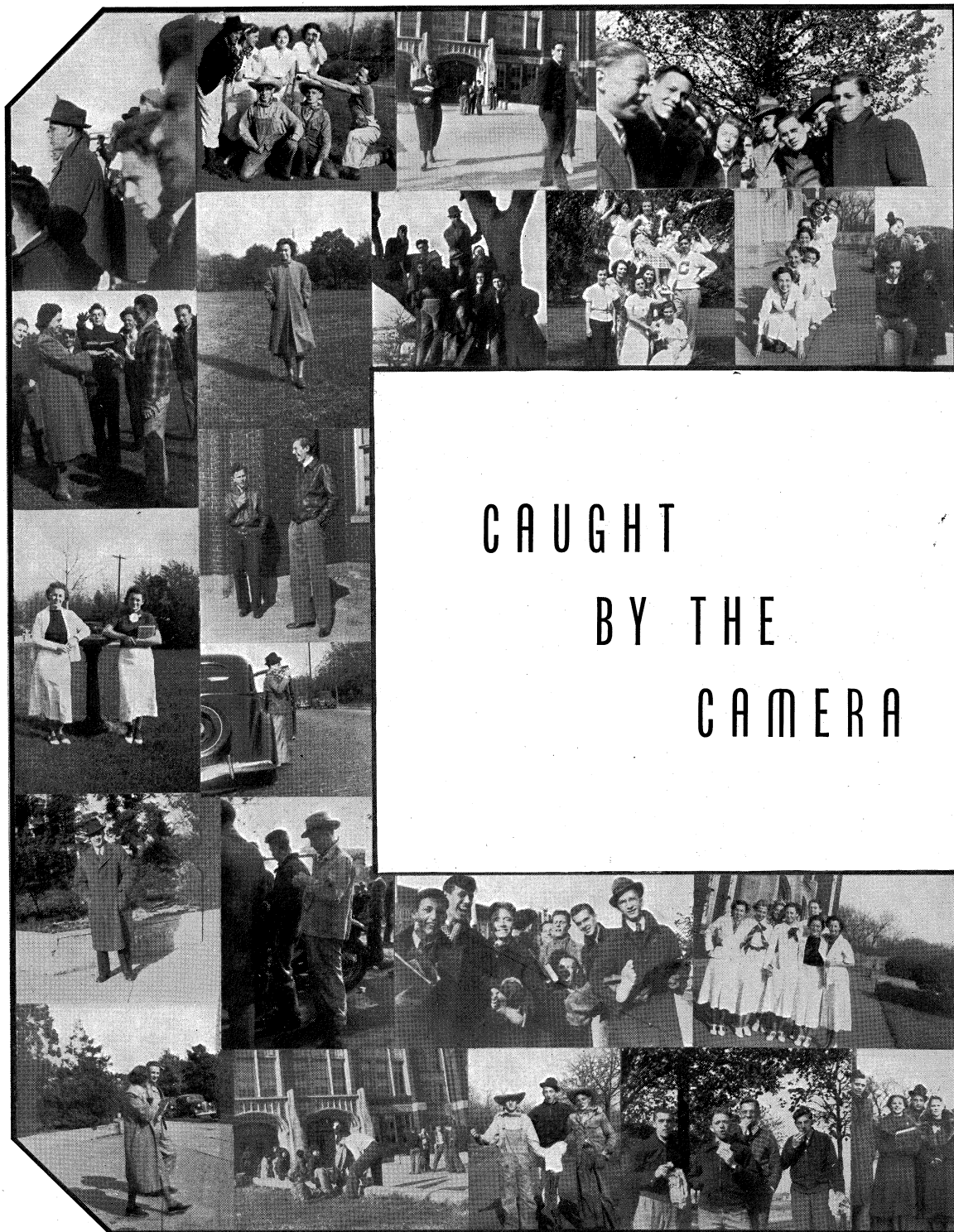
I have learned life's greatest lessons
