Delaware Thompson, 28 years old, of West Chester, Pa., formerly of 716 South Eighth street, Camden, shot and killed Miss Addie Hacker. aged 23 years, of Little, Pa, a really beautiful girl, in the second-story front room of the home of his sister, Mrs. K. S. Lewis, at 534 Trenton avenue, Camden, shortly before noon yesterday. He then placed the revolver o his right temple, pulled the trigger and

fell a corpse at the girls' side. \* On the young woman's body this note was found: We wish to die together. MISS ADDIE HACKER,
