## Mystery in the Death of Pole in Camden—Five Men Plåced Under Arrest

Coroner Latchfield is investigating the death of Frank Tainnsha, a Pole, 35 sers old, of Olynhant, Pa, whose body was found early setterday morning at the foot of a starway at 1940 Diamond street, Canden Jacob Chopper, Peter Opliaki, John Schwenze, John Yamank and Stanlaus Wernshi, Hungarian, who cannot speak English, were arrested by Comty Detextives Smith and Cherry on susperion of Japoning comething about Taianoshi's death.

Shouly after 3 o'clock yesterday morning Conore Lichfield was awalened by two men, who told hum to go to 1040 Damond street, where a man was being killed. Tunnking it was a ruse to get hum out of the house to do hum bookly inpury the Gorner richfield as one we went to the house and tound Taxanob's body at the house the line given for more the tour.

Nothing could be gleaned from the men, who told conflicting stores. One, who said he was a room-mate of the dead man, stated he had arrived home late and had fallen over the hody. On examining the body the Coroner found Taianosh had received a bad fracture of the skull, which had cau-ed he death
