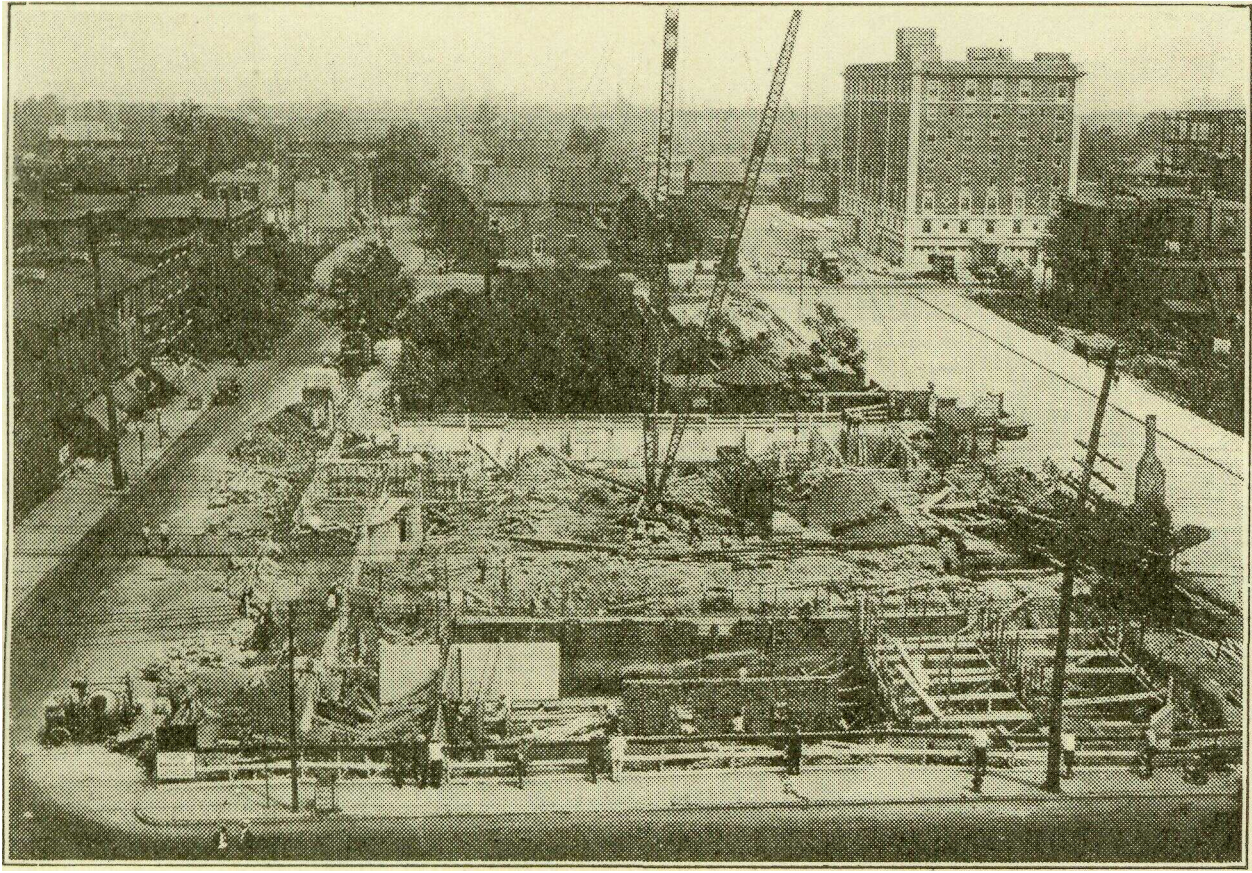
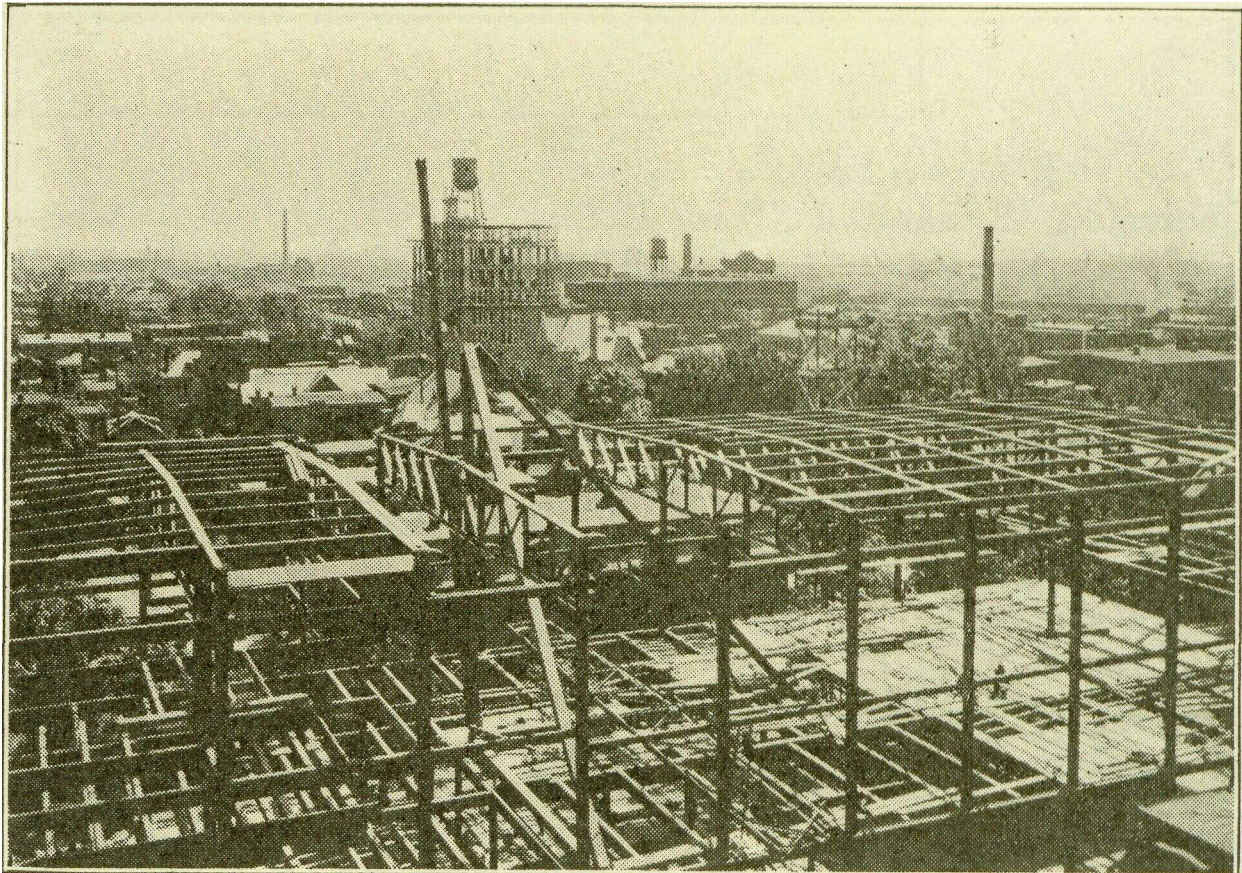


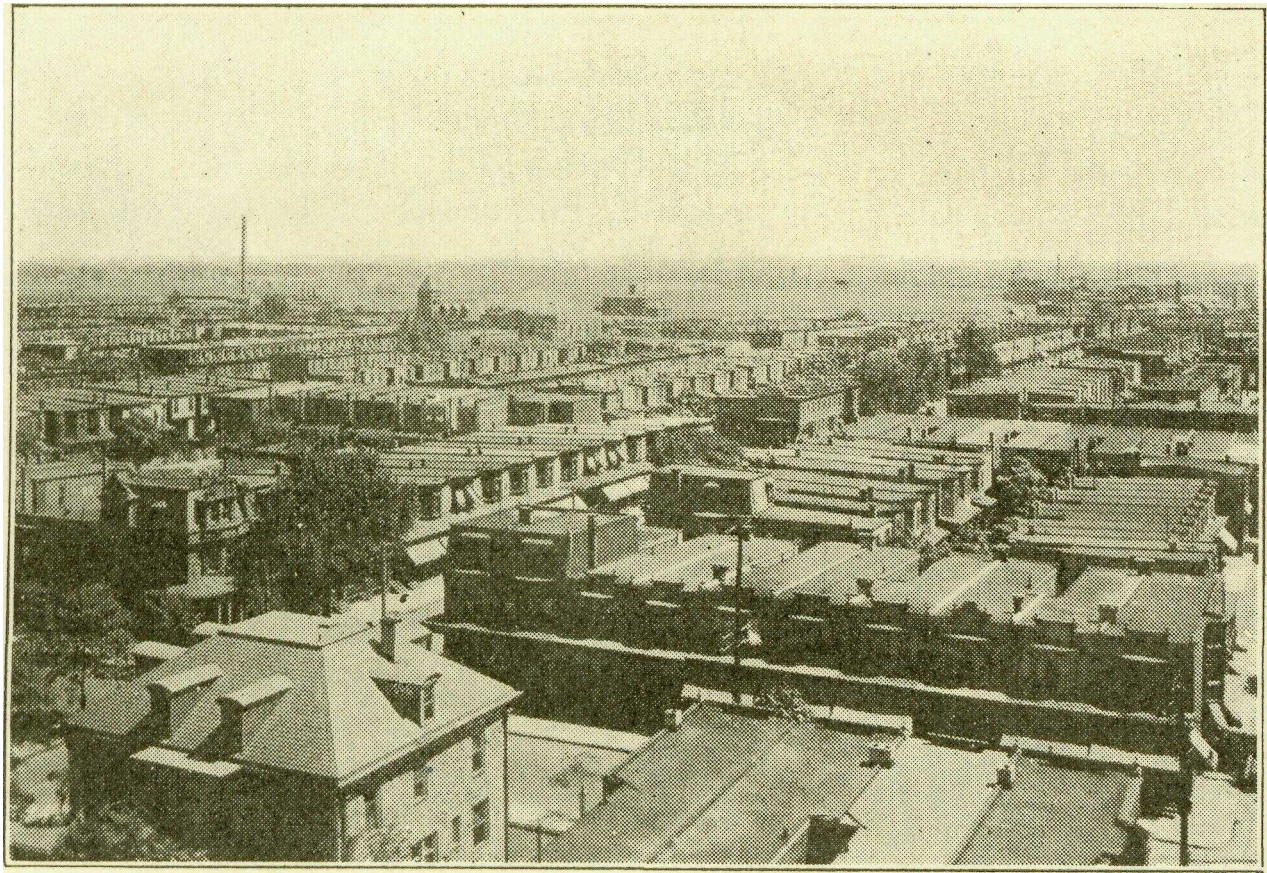

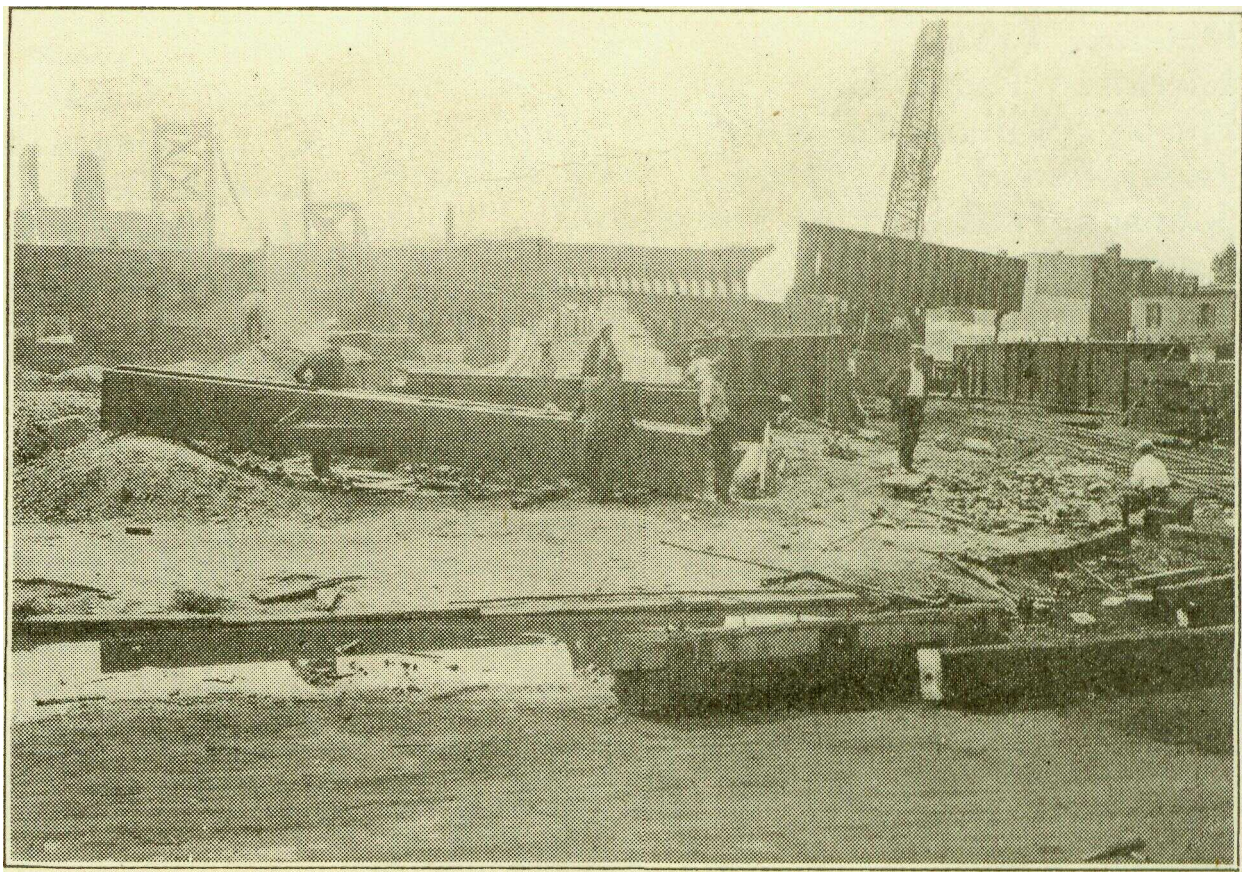
A view of the Walt Whitman Hotel from the Court House—

seen on the extreme right of the Walt Whitman.



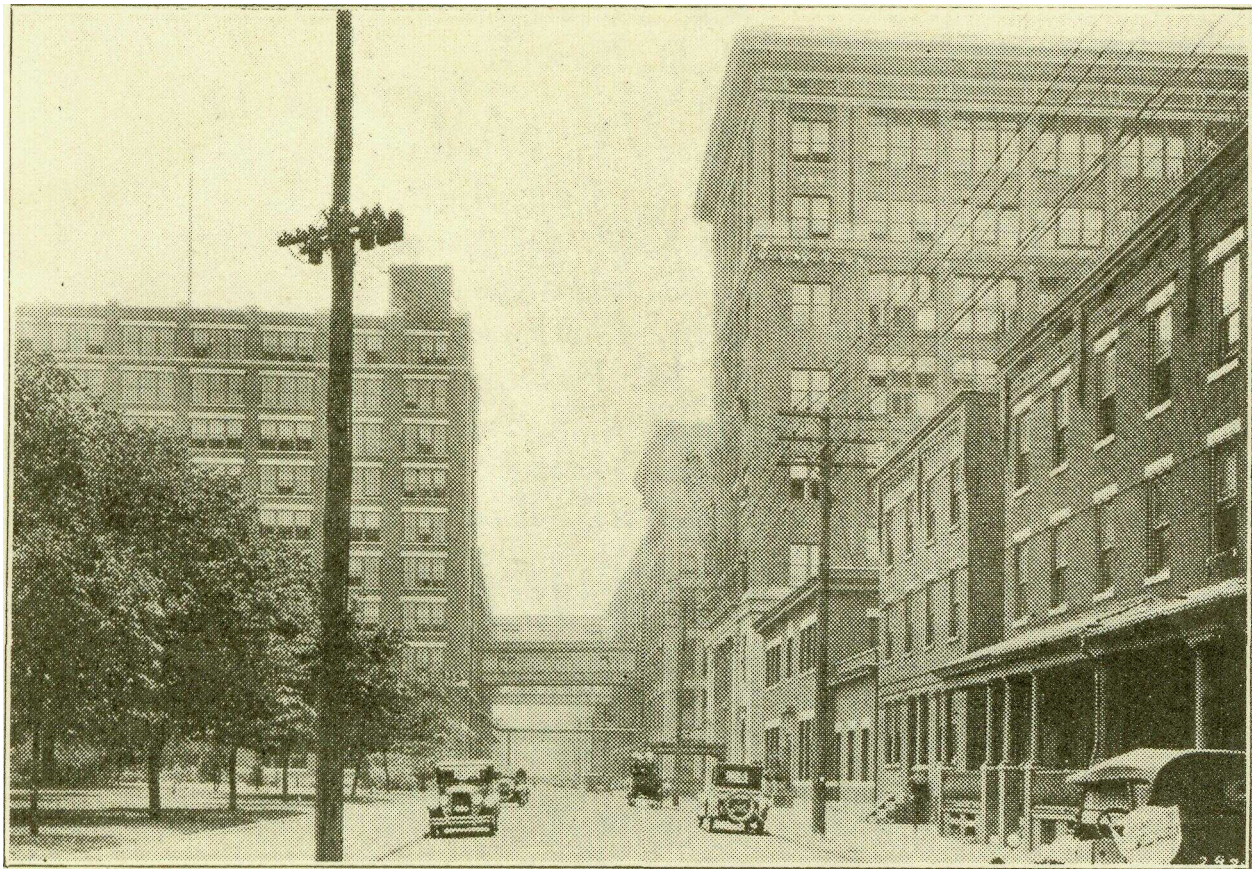
Steel super-structure of the Elks one-half million dollar home
