Tokenergy Cornog and Climes were attracted by the shooting and joined in the chase. The news spread like wilding, and a pose of clitzens was soon organized. They covered every exit from the swamp. Two houry later the performed an astreat by Cornoy. The enforce called on him to surrender, but Willis turned back to the swamp, while Cornog followed and empited his revolver at him.
