to the Cooper Hospital. There doctors pronounced the boy dead.

Captain Price in the meantime had told of the three unconscious firemen inside the burning building, who were in imminent danger of death should the floor fall in.

Rescuers immediately dashed into the burning structure and brought out their comrades and all were rushed to the hospital.

The building, a two-story brick edifree, was directly behind the Larie Theatre, where a crowded audience was witnessing a motion picture performoff the store and the store of the free, and fearing is panicky significant the orchestra continued to play, and the operator was given orders to contine the picture then showing for ten minutes. Then the smoke became noticeable within the theatre, and the left the theatre quictly, without any sign of fear or panic.

Three slarms were turned in during the fire, and the building was practically destroyed.
