Items of Interest from the Cities and Towns Across the Delaware.

Mrs Lizzie Fullerton, who was committed to the county jail by Justice Wright of Gloucester City, for disorderly conduct, and who afterwards was the justice arrested for misconduct in office, was released by Judge Wescott yesterday on a writ of habeas corpus.

A slight fire, caused by an overheated stove occurred at the dwelling of Mrs. Mary Ambruster, No. 1205 Lyons street, yesterday afternoon. The damage was trifling.

A certificate of incorporation of the "Electric Gas Light" Company was filed in the county clerk's office yesterday. The capital stock is \$20,000, divided in 200 shares of \$100 each.

A certificate titled the "Malvage Sewing Machine" Company was also filed in the county clerk's office yesterday. The capital stock is \$500 000.

Mayor Pratt has appointed the following on the police force in place of the Democratic officers who have resigned: Samuel Lee and W. Pedrick, Fourth ward; Christian Tenter, Sixth ward, and Henry Peters, Seventh ward.

H. Cowperthwait, of the Seventh ward, was committed to the county jail yesterday by Justice Barr, in default of bail, charged with failing to support his family.
