DOG LED WAY TO Drowned Child

Four-Year-Old Boy Became Fastened in Mud at the Bottom of a Pond and Perished

The body of Henry May, Ji., the 4 yearold son of Mr. and Mrs. Henry May, of 208 Burns street, Camden, was found in a pond at the head of North Second street resterday by John Dyer, of 216 Buins street, and Policeman Isaac Toy, boy disappeared from his home Saturday afternoon, and the local police and heighbors had been looking for him for many hours. When found the body was standing upright with the tins of the fingers appearing above the surface of the wa ter. From the position of the body it has supposed the child was wading in the pond and suddenly soing into deep water became fastened in the thick mud, the water conering and drowning vonus May.

A colle dog, a pet of the drowned boy, attracted the attention of Dyer by running bick and forward from the pond to the house for several hours.

Henty was his parents' only son, and the father is suffering from nervous prostration, while the mother is distracted.
