GOVERNOR WERTS HAS FIXED THE DAY FOR HIS EX-ECUTION.

Kalrer's Murderer to Die on December 10-He, Says He Trusts in His Counsel and Divine Providence to Save Him.

Governor Werts, of New Jersey, has fixed December 10 as the date for the execution of Theodore Lambert, the Camden colored murdert. The the Camden colored murdert. The date first fixed for the execution was December 13, ISM, which was a little over a year from the time Lambert shot William G. Kairer, the Camden cracker baker, while robbing his house in South Camden.

Through John I. Semple, his counest, hte Governor granted a reprieve until January J. 1805. His counsel then contested the legality of the reprieve on constitutional grounds, and the case was taken to the Supreme the case was taken to the Supreme Court decided that the reprieve was legal.

legal, Governor, Werts issued another death warrant, fixing June 27 last ps the time for Lambert's execution. Another appeal waz taken to the United States Supreme Court, Lawyes Semple claiming the Governor had no author-Hr to issue a second death warrant. Hr to issue a second death warrant. Supreme Court was decided on Novembor 18, against the prisoner. Lawyer Semple has appealed to the New Jersey Court of Pardons to reconsider Lambert's case, but there is not much likelihood of favorable action.

Lambert was playing checkers with William Thein, a white man, who is yet to be tried for the alleged murder of his former mistress, when he was informed yesterday afternoon of the Governor's action.

"I trust in my counsel, but I trust more in my God," he said. Lambert has professed religious conversion since he was condemned to die. He has grown stout and is a well-behaved prisoner.
