## SEMPLE GIVES UP AT LAST

A Reprieve Refused and Lambert's Doom is Scaled.

Lawyer John L. Semple, who has so pluckly and successfully stood between Murderer Theodore Lambert and the gallows, is outwitted by the law at last. Yesterday he played his last card and lost. He made a final appeal to Governor Werts at Trenton for'a reprieve, so he could again bring Lambert's case before the Board of Pardons. The Governor re-fused the request. He said Lambert had had, full justice and he would take the responsibility for not giving him another chance for his life. Lawyer Semple admits that this closes the case.

Notices were sent out yesterday to the persons who have been designated to witness the execution. Lambert's cofin is ready. It was made nearly a year are.
