CAMDEN, N. J., Dec. 19.—A peculiar legal more was made to day by Lawyer John L. Semple before Judge Garrison in behalf of Theodore Lambort, who is under sentence to be hanged on Jaunary 3. Lambert was to have been hung for murder on December 4 last, but Lawyer Semple obtained a reviewe from the governor until January 3, penu. ~ an application to the beard of pardons for a commutation of sentence. The beard refused to interfere and to-day Mr. Semple went into court and asked for the discharge of his client from prison on the ground that he is legally dead.

Mr. Semple's contention was that under the constitution the governor had no right to reprive Lambert and as he was not exocuted on the day fixed by law he cannot now be hanged legally and should be discharged as the law has no claim on him. Mr. Scmple asked for swrit of habcas corpusto release his clout and Judge Garrison set down uoxt Saturday to hear the argument in the case.
