Chestnut to Watson, Chestnut avenue to Biddle, Central avenue to Fremont, Cooper avenue to Twenty-seventh street, Delaware avenue to Hagan, Elm to Copley, Erie to Saunders, Evans to Hobart, Folwell to Carman, Fifth to Hayes avenue, Filimore avenue to Wayne, Fourth to River avenue, Front to Essex, George to Rand, Grant avenue to Concord, Howard to Dupont, Jefferson to Boyd, Main to Brant, Maple to Trinity, Master to Canton, Park to Hollis, Penn avenue to Arnold, St. John to Bank, Fourth to Hanover, Benson to Mickle, River road to River avenue, New Cove road to Thirty sixth street. Seventh to Sherman avenue, First to Twentyeighth, Boothman to Twenty-fourth, Centre to Thirty-third. Central to Thirty-second. Penn to High, Washington to Chase, Second to Twenty-ninth, Second avenue to German, Sixth to Arthur avenue, Spruce to Emerson, State to Mariton avenue, Taylor avenue to Astor. Third to Bryant, Third, from Westfield avenue to north of Pleasant, to Thirtieth; Van Buren avenue to Putnam, Walnut to Temple, Washington avenue to Carman, Westminster avenue to Mickle, Wright avenue to Morse, Fol-

The charge of the solid Camden follow: Arthe charged, Cleveland terrace to Kent pare, Church place to Chapel place, Fulton place to Waverly, Dayton to Gardeu, Green to Dana, Griffee aller to Dean aller, Harrison to Randall, Howell to Camac, Lincoln to Douglass, Sewell to Porter, Union place to Campbell place.

In making the changes over two hundred street signs will have to be put up.
