
FLAG GAUGHT BREEZE, BIG Pole went down

Staff in Front of Camden City Hall Fell With a Crash and Narrowly Missed Pedestrians

With a crash that not only startled the neighborhood, but also missed several podestrinas by a narrow margin, the 124foot flag pole in front of the Canden City Ifail toppled over yestenday. In honor of Chief of Police John Forter an eight by twelve foot flag was dring at half mait. The strong northwest wind ben/the pole it tumes like a reed. About Th_Q clock a load crackling was bend, and then fell.

The extreme end crashed through a network of wres, snapping them like hread. Through several of the wires the deadly electric current was passing, which emitted blue sparks as the ends dangled over the heads of terro-striket nedsatinas. The pharnacy of Dr. William Shafer, at Wright and Haddon avenues, would have been wrecked but for a coavenient and stout telegraph pole.

The flag staff was supposed to be a solid spruce pine spar, but it was found to have rotted through the centre. It had stood service for eleven years.
