The Fire Department Kept Busy All Day-A \$10,000 Blaze.

The Camden Fire Department was kept husy yesterday responding to alarms. The first slarm was about 11 o'clock in the morning, when the firemen were called out by a slight fire at the house of Howard Snyder, at 1152 Cooper street. The fire originated from a detective range. Loss, \$50.
