## YOUNG WOODWARD INDICTED BY JURY

He Is Charged With Robbery and Murder in the Bill Presented to Judge Garrison

Two indictments against Paul Woodward, charging him with the murder of John Coffin and W. Price Jennings, the two boys whose bodies were found in a field near Haddon Heights, October-4, were presented before Jadge Garrison in Camden yesterday by the grand jury. In the indictments it is charged-that Woodward caused the boys deaths by administering strychnine. The motive for the erime is charged in the indictment'as robbery.

Following the presentment by the grand jury Jadge Garrison heard argument on the writ of habese corpus obtained by Woodward's counsel last Tuesday. At the conclusion Jadge Garrison announced that he considered the two inductments sufficient to warrant the court in reluison bail. He then declined to make an order for Woodward's release on bail.

Wednesday, November 12, was set down as the date for the trial.
